- When Simeon saw Jesus for the first time, what do you think he thought or felt? Have you ever felt that way about Jesus?
- Why do you think God chose to come to earth as a baby?
- Read Philippians 2:5-11. Why was Jesus' birth such a sacrifice for God?
- This Christmas, what's one way you plan to respond to the gift God has given you?
- How do you think God might be calling you to continue responding to the gift of Jesus even after Christmas is over?
